5. Institute of Advanced Research follows the evaluation system as per UGC rules mentioned in the Choice Based Credit System.
6. Credit: One credit of Theory is equivalent to one hour of faculty student interaction per week for 15 weeks, and two hours of Practicals per week for 15 weeks.
7. Examinations: The examinations include internal and external evaluation.
8. The internal evaluation includes midterm test, class tests, assignments, seminars, course work and industrial visits where applicable.
9. The semester end final examinations are set by external paper setters. The semester end examinations include practicals and written examinations.
10. Evaluation for each subject varies due to different evaluation criteria. The total marks for the subject is based on weightage for each criteria. If evaluation criteria do not form part of evaluation it is marked "N/A".
11. The students who do not attempt any specific paper are marked "A" for absent.
12. Some subjects are such where the students have to show satisfactory performance to pass. They are reflected as "S" in the mark sheet.
13. Re-examinations: Students are allowed to take two re-examination for any subject to improve their scores. The highest marks of all examinations are reflected in the mark sheet. The re-examination marks are earmarked with a \* in the mark sheet.

14. Pass Marks: The minimum pass marks for each subject is 33 %.
15. Pass / Fail: A student is assessed as "Pass" for the subject if he/she attains more than 33% marks.
16. Grade point (GP): Grade Point for each subject is calculated by dividing the maximum marks by 10.
17. Credit Point (CP): is calculated by multiplying the GP by the total credits for the subject.
18. The Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA): is calculated by adding the CP of all the subjects and dividing by the total credits for all subjects. Subjects where evaluation is "S" are not included.
19. Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA): CGPA is the total CP for all semesters divided by the total credits. The credits where evaluation is SAT are not included.
20. **Authentication:** Each mark sheet, certificate has an Authentication Number. You can check the authentication of a document by submitting the Authentication no. on <http://iar.ac.in/webauthentication.aspx>. You will get a copy of the original document for authentication.
21. Percentage: The percentage for a semester can be calculated by the formula: - SGPA\*10.
