Instructions to students:

- ii. Mode of Examination: Online Open Book Examination.
- iii. Any knowledge resources (books, web etc.) are allowed to be used.
- iv. Collaborations (taking help of other students/persons) are not permitted.
- v. The answer-sheets will be strictly checked for plagiarism. Any plagiarism will be considered unfair means (cheating). That will be subjected to Unfair Means Procedures.
